



Q2 Do you approve the use of ESSER III funds to improve school conditions for student learning with smaller class size?



Q3 Do you approve the development and implementation of procedures and systems to improve the preparedness and response efforts of GSISD with HVAC upgrades?



Q4 Do you approve the purchase of supplies to sanitize and clean the facilities of the district?



Q5 Do you approve the districts efforts to recruit, support, and retain effective teachers, principals, and staff?


