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Course Overview

Course Goals

- Play with proper posture, embouchure, and tone quality.
- Count and perform rhythms with accuracy.
- Demonstrate care and maintenance of their instrument.
- Perform beginning-level band repertoire with appropriate dynamics and phrasing.
